Distance: 17 km | Duration: approx. 90 min | Terrain: flat on concrete path

As we sail upstream into the Tonle River, our guide will offer an insightful presentation on the geography of the Mekong and Tonle Rivers before lunchtime.

Afternoon Excursion: Kampong Tralach Countryside

In the afternoon, we explore the rural landscapes of Kampong Tralach. An ox-cart ride takes us along winding riverside paths, passing picturesque rice paddies and small villages. We visit a local NGO school and library project, learning about the community's education initiatives. Alternatively, guests may choose to visit a nearby 300-year-old temple and Buddha shrine, offering a glimpse into Cambodia's deep spiritual heritage.

Optional Afternoon Excursion:

Cycling Experience:

Pedal through the heartland of Cambodia, passing through Lungvek, the former royal capital, and the Buddha Jade Temple (built in 1560). Along the way, observe fishermen casting their nets into the tranquil waters of the Tonle River, a timeless sight that reflects Cambodia's deep connection to the waterways.

Distance: 14 km | Duration: approx. 120 min | Terrain: flat on concrete path

As the sun begins to set, unwind at the bar during happy hour while we sail toward Prek Bangkong, our next destination. After dinner, enjoy a classic film at our nightly onboard cinema, bringing another incredible day to a close.

Day 5: Prek Bangkong – Kampong Cham (Mekong) – Angkor Ban – Phnom Penh

Morning Excursion: Discovering Kampong Cham

We begin the day in Kampong Cham, an important trade and transportation hub along the Mekong River. Despite its growing economic role, the town retains its traditional charm, with small artisan villages scattered along its outskirts. Our morning excursion takes us to Cheung Krok, where locals craft handmade goods—from food products to traditional clothing—using techniques passed down through generations. Guests will also have the chance to visit the seasonal Bamboo Bridge, an engineering marvel that serves as both a functional crossing and a cultural link to Cambodia's past.

Cycling Adventure to Koh Pen:

For those seeking a more active experience, embark on a cycling journey to the island of Koh Pen. Ride through verdant vegetable fields and tobacco plantations, passing local artisans and Khmer bee masters tending to their hives. This excursion offers a unique glimpse into Cambodia's rural way of life, where traditions remain deeply rooted in everyday work.

Distance: 16 km | Duration: approx. 120 min | Terrain: flat on concrete path

Back onboard, as we continue our journey downstream toward Angkor Ban, our crew showcases traditional Khmer fashions, displaying the elegant attire worn by locals during special occasions.

Afternoon Excursion: Visiting Angkor Ban

After lunch, we arrive in Angkor Ban, a unique village known for its well-preserved wooden stilt houses and deep sense of community. Here, guests can explore a monastery, where we will have the opportunity to meet monks during their afternoon class. As we wander through the village, we gain an intimate look at the daily rhythms of Cambodian rural life, meeting local families and capturing beautiful moments of traditional living.

Optional Afternoon Excursions:

Culinary Experience:

For those interested in Cambodian cuisine, an alternative excursion takes guests to the home of Mr. B., a former cruise ship chef who returned to his home village. Here, we will prepare Samlor Korko, a traditional fish soup made with roasted rice, vegetables, herbs, and spices, accompanied by a duck egg omelette.

Cycling Adventure:

A cycling journey through Angkor Ban offers a peaceful ride past seasonal vegetable fields, centuries-old wooden houses, and traditional blacksmith workshops, where skilled artisans craft metalwork using techniques passed down through generations. The excursion concludes with a refreshing stop to enjoy ice-cold local beer or freshly pressed sugar cane juice.

Distance: 10 km | Duration: approx. 120 min | Terrain: flat on concrete path
